Joint Informational Meeting of the Elko New Market City Council and the New Market Township Board. Purpose of the meeting was to invite public input on the Orderly Annexation of the Adleman Property. The meeting was held at the Elko New Market City Hall.
January 26, 2012

City Mayor called the meeting to order at 6:35 PM

The City Mayor explained the purpose of the meeting and had the City Council and the Township Board introduce their selves.

The City Administrator presented the OAA. Explaining the modification from the OAA drawn up in 2007. The availability of Metropolitan Council Interceptor being on line, which it now is and adding the ability for Detachment of Property back to the Township if no development occurs within three years.

The Township Chairperson explained the public comment procedure.

The City Mayor requested participation from the audience. A City resident had a question on the three different parcels in the OAA, Are they all owned by one party? Answer is yes. A Township resident asked the Town Board for their comments on the annexation. The Board explained if development was to occur it had to be in the City for sewer and water as being the Township cannot supply. Another Township resident was interested in the per acre payment to the Township. What portion of the property does the payment apply to? Resident was told it applies to all land that is not right of way or wetlands. There was some discussion on wetlands and mitigation. All questions were answered to the satisfaction of every one.
